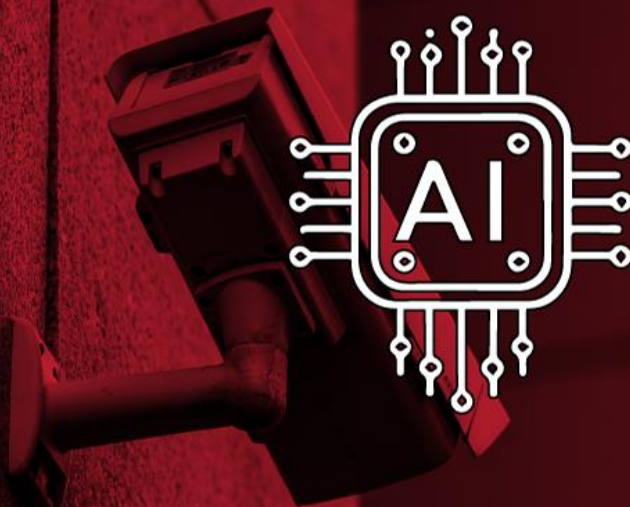

Overview
